Dear Residents:

Recently it has been noted that the water bills for the Park are exceptionally high. You, as residents, enjoy the benefit of not having to pay for the water you use. However, this letter is to remind you that southern California is experiencing a drought, and in some areas water-use restriction measures have already been put into place. It could happen here, also, so please be mindful that it is up to all of us to help conserve water.

We would request that individuals not water the perimeter of their home sites repeatedly to keep *the possibility of dust* from occurring. Other areas observed where water usage could be curtailed are the showers and soaker hoses in the yard.

Please check your faucets and toilets for possible leaks. A small drip will amount to many gallons of water in a short period of time. Excess water could adversely affect the septic system as well.

With everyone working together to make small changes we can jointly have a positive affect in conserving water. Please do your part to make this happen.
