Re: Rule Violations

Dear Mr. Naughton and Ms. Barnes:

The Park managers have advised me that recently they, and other residents, found scattered all around the Park, in a somewhat deliberate manner, all types of paperwork addressed to you that had to do with the legal issues that you have been engaged in concerning the Park. I personally saw the large bag of collected "trash." This "material" has subsequently been disposed of.

Additionally, it has been observed that you have a wooden and upholstered chair in your front yard that needs to be removed; you have a pile of dried plant trimmings in the rear yard – adjacent to the RV storage area – which are a fire hazard and should be disposed of in the dumpster. The white lattice covering your carport entrance was not pre-approved and is not allowed and should be removed immediately, and the area of your carport, for which you have had prior write-ups, cleaned up and all articles placed in a storage cabinet or disposed of. Your continued resistance in cleaning and clearing this area subjects you to possible termination of residency based on rule violations.

You have been observed walking a dog and subsequently animal waste deposits have been found in the location where the dog is walked. Management wants to stress that it is standard procedure that animal waste must be removed immediately, and if you have not done so in past please be sure and clean up after your dog in the future.

See the enclosed copies of the Rules, pages 6, 7, 10 and 20 which substantiate the above requests.
